

GIGI ROSSO *Piedmont*

Gigi Rosso's winery in Castiglione Falletto, in the heart of the Barolo zone, is the center of vinification for the grapes they grow and the exceptional wines they produce on their four estates. The experienced choice of land, the passionate care of the vineyards, as well as the careful selection of grapes during the harvest, allow Gigi Rosso to grow splendid grapes each year. Forty years of winemaking tradition and passion add to their world class examples of Piedmont's great wines.



Barolo Arione

Grapes: 100% Nebbiolo

Alcohol: 13%

Vinification: Arione is an important Barolo sub-zone which is a single vineyard located in Serralunga D'Alba. Planted in 1960, the vineyard is 3 hectares. The grape production is quite small and selected handpicking allow for only 20,000 bottles to be made annually. This is a classic Barolo that ages 3 years in large oak barrels and achieves an extraordinary concentration of fruit complemented by intense herb, mineral and earth character.

Tasting Note: Barolo Arione has a distinguished and delicate ethereal bouquet. This wine is rich and complex with smooth body. On the palate the wine shows leather, herbs, black cherries and sardines. It's a classic and elegant Barolo.



Barolo Arjone

Sors Dell'Uivo

Grapes: 100% Nebbiolo

Alcohol: 13%

Vinification: For over 100 years in this small vineyard an olive tree has survived cold winters testifying to the exceptional microclimate here. The grapes reach optimum maturity before harvesting. After pressing the wine is aged five years in small Slavonian oak casks where it develops intense color and bouquet. This wine is only produced in exceptional vintage years.

Tasting Note:



Dolcetto Diano

d'Alba Moncolombetto

Grapes: 100% Dolcetto

Alcohol: 12%

Vinification: Moncolombetto is a spectacular vineyard perched 500 meters above sea level. Its sunny exposure and steep calcereous soil produce an intense purple wine that is complex and forward with fruit. Rigorous hand selection of grapes and stainless steel fermentation insure rich fruit concentration and flowery bouquet.

Tasting Note: This unique wine is striking purple in color with a complex and flowery bouquet. On the palate the wine is rich, dry and fruity with distinct notes of almonds. Excellent with pasta, fresh cheeses or light main courses.



Barbera D'Alba

Rocca Giovinio

Grapes: 100% Barbera

Alcohol: 12.5%

Vinification: This single vineyard Barbera is a young inviting wine with a delicate floral bouquet and deep purple color. Selected grape harvesting and stainless steel fermentation maintain bouquet and freshness.

Tasting Note: Medium-bodied and smooth with good acidity. As a young wine, it shows fresh fruit and notes of almonds. With age becoming more complex with blackcherry and tar flavors.





Barbaresco

Vigneto Viglino

Grapes: 100% Nebbiolo
Alcohol: 12%

Vinification: Viglino is a small vineyard in the Giacosa sub-zone of Treiso d'Alba in the Barbaresco area. The wine is aged two years in Slavonian oak casks and it rivals Barolo for its elegance and refinement.

Tasting Note: This traditional wine combines the astringent dryness of the Nebbiolo grape with the softness of its fruit and delicate bouquet of roses.



Gavi di Gavi

Grapes: 100% Cortese
Alcohol: 12%

Vinification: The name "Gavi di Gavi" refers to a wine which is entirely derived from grapes produced in the municipality of Gavi; the heart of the Cortese doc zone

Tasting Note: Pale straw yellow color, fresh and delicate bouquet with exotic hues. Dry, medium-bodied, smooth and harmonious taste with a clean finish. It has a slightly superior alcoholic content with a light almond aftertaste.



Roero Arneis

Grapes: 100% Arneis
Alcohol: 12%

Vinification: The Arneis grape variety takes its name from a word in Piedmontese dialect which means "whimsical", like the grapevines from this Roero Wine district. From the steep sandy vineyards of this zone comes this extraordinary wine, Roero Arneis. Single vineyard Cascina Rivetto - Monteu Roero, producing approximately 20,000 bottles per year.

Tasting Note: Pale straw-like greenish color, very intense bouquet of forest flowers and poignant, persistent aroma with an almond-like backtaste. It is a white wine with great character, ideal as an aperitif or served with cold appetizers.
